THE CITY OF LIGNANO SABBIADORO

Lignano Sabbiadoro stands on a long sandy peninsula covered with pine trees, the southwestern end of the beautiful Marano lagoon nature reserve. Its slight slope, the sandy beach in front of the Coast of Istria, a safe bathing for families and the active nightlife, make it a popular resort for Italian and foreign tourists. The extreme point of the peninsular area is divided into three districts: Lignano Sabbiadoro is one of them and is accompanied by Lignano Pineta, 1 km further south, and Lignano Riviera, more recent but still all centred in its natural features, also given the close ness of the Tagliamento River. In total there are just under 7,000 residents. The name of the



resort was originally Lignano, in 1935 'Sabbiadoro' was added exclusively for promotional purposes. The development of the tourist resort began in the early twentieth century, when after the reclamation began the construction of some bathing establishments, however accessible only by boat from the lagoon. Before that, nothing existed in these places, except a small area of refuge for some fishermen. The ancient plans of the Serenissima, duly compiled by the so-called Water Savi, made no mention of either the name or the characteristic of the area, considered in the complex of the important lagoon territory. The wonderful beach, however, could not go unnoticed for much longer and the first hotel was built

in 1903. Its urban growth, however, was delayed, not only because of the malarial area in the vicinity, but also because of the lack of basic infrastructure: it had to wait more than two decades before the construction of the main and vital road artery. Today's city has reached the maturity of urban planning and infrastructure in the best way and presents itself with a wide variety of attractions. Moving between its neighbourhoods is possible through urban transport managed by the SAF, but Lignano is also to be explored on foot or perhaps by bike. Riviera, the western part of the peninsula is characterized by the villas and residential condominiums, all gracefully decorated with beautiful pine trees; Pineta, in the city centre, has a modest shopping mall, famous beaches and a plethora of venues suitable for evening and night fun; Sabbiadoro, at the extreme tip of the peninsula, contains a lively shopping mall and even more night and cultural life than the previous ones. The hotel presence in general is remarkable. For those who want to enjoy the maximum stay at the seaside, we recommend the baths of Lignano, located in the Riviera area and immersed in the centuries-old pine forest (directions: waterfront R. Riva 1) or even the numerous spas and fitness centers of the city. In addition to the exclusively seaside attractions, Lignano also offers some historical and naturalistic itineraries. The original farmer's core, placed close to the lagoon, has two typical rural houses of sure interest, probably dated from the 17th century. The religious cult for centuries has concentrated in the small church of St. Zacharias and the fifteenth century church of Santa Maria, in the resort of Bevazzana, and in the interior of which is noticed a series of frescoes of the 15th century. The Hemingway Park is a park of botanical interest that covers 4 hectares of land and is named after the famous American writer who visited the resort during his stay in Italy. The writer is also dedicated to the prestigious "Ernest Hemingway Lignano Sabbiadoro Prize" in journalism, fiction and non-fiction. The Punta Verde Zoo Park is a natural oase with ponds,





animals (1200 specimens belonging to 200 different species) in semi-open areas and eco-environmental paths. The nature in Lignano is also enriched by the UNICEF Park, born in the late 1980s, dedicated to children in as many as 4 hectares of entertainment between skating rinks, mini golf, swimming pools, bike paths and much more. The natural attraction, however, remains the Oase of the Wwf Laguna in Marano. Birdwatchers will be able to observe birds of prey such as the marsh hawk, the osprey, the buzzer, the small and real hen harrier, the kestrel, the brown kite. Don't miss it.

By car you can reach Lignano driving on the A4 Venice - Trieste motorway or on A23 motorway linking Tarvisio and Venice; the motorway exit for Lignano is made at Latisana, following the local road no 354 which ends at Lignano.

There are many bus lines which regularly depart from the



The CMAS 17th Junior European Finswimming Championship 2020 will be held in Lignano Sabbiadoro (UD), at the Bella Italia Sports Village, located in a valuable position within the urban fabric of Lignano Sabbiadoro, in Central Avenue, 29. It consists of a modern tourist-social center, nestled in 60 hectares of verdant pine forest. The tranquility, fragrant aroma of pines and sea saloons. the clear sea and the beach front reserved exclusively for guests of the Village (1120 meters long and 60 meters deep) create the ideal environment for toning individual holidays or groups, in the name of sport, relaxation and fun, Twelve kilometres of roads and trails run throughout the area, creating amene solutions for racing, running, promenade and plain air, all routes can be excluded from car traffic. The whole village is dotted with outdoor sports camps; it also offers some high-quality solutions for all sports disciplines indiscriminately within the multifunctional palace, which can accommodate up to three thousand people

SOME RECALLS FOR PARTICIPATION

Only national federation teams affiliated to the CMAS are eligible to compete in the competition. Each national team should respect the rules of Championships, the safety conditions set by the organizers, the "Detailed protocol for the holding of international Finswimming competitions taking place in Italy" (attached) and CMAS rules and regulations.

- Swimming-pool events: (art. 3.3.3a. 8.1.3.6. 8.1.3.7. Finswimming rules)
 - o Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each distance and one (1) relay team.
 - o For relay races the names of the swimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the results office before the start of the session. The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females and starting order is free. Any change in the fixed starting order leads to disqualification.
 - It's possible to change the composition of the relay teams between the qualifying heats and the final.
 - The entries must reach CMAS headquarters within the time limits set by the CMAS rules on www.cmasoffice.org (§ Point 1.21.1.3 &4 of CMAS Procedures).
 - o World and Continental Championships will be organized over four (4) days and eight (8) sessions.
 - The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon except 400IM, 800SF and 1500SF slow heats in the morning and fast heat in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested to the national federations to send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all selection national competitions in delay maximum of two weeks after the competitions (in one of the three CMAS languages). Thus, times of enrolments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS Championships. If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, times of corresponding enrolments will be cancelled and the athletes will be engaged with time 00:00:00.

- Bi Fins (BF): 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m

BOTTLE FILLING

- Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed.
- For pool competitions, the minimum volume of a compressed air cylinder (bottle) is liter 0.4 (zero point four liter).
- The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa).
- When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed.
- All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than 2 years before the competition, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.
- Each cylinder must be presented empty during checking meeting before competition. The organizer guarantees the filling of DIN 200, YOKE, cylinders (bottles).

VARIOUS

National teams should bring **two (2)** national flags (m 2,00 x m. 1,00) and a CD with the national anthem (short version).

ACCOMMODATION



BELLA ITALIA SPORTS VILLAGE

The center consists of thirteen residences with 700 rooms, able to accommodate up to two thousand eight hundred people. The rooms are all with reserved indoor toilets, widely lit with direct light, some with balcony and sea views; accessibility to them is free of any barrier; many are predisposed to accommodate people with disabilities.





BOOKING & ENTRY FEES

Junior Finswimming European Championship from 06/10/2020 to 12/10/2020

Entry fee per participant is **700,00 Euro in multiple rooms.** Extra charges for **single room** is **50,00 Euro/day**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms full board;
- Drinking water during the meals included.

Finswimming European Championship + Junior Finswimming European Championship from 02/10/2020 to 12/10/2020 (for those who will take part in both events)

Entry fee per participant is **1.100,00 Euro in multiple rooms.** Extra charges for <u>single room</u> is **50,00 Euro/day**. The organizer will provide:

- Accommodation in three-star hotels with double or triple hotel rooms full board;
- Drinking water during the meals included.

Full board accommodation is considered as breakfast, warm lunch, warm dinner and water drink per meal included.

Participants who choose to be accommodated in hotels other than official will have to pay 250,00 Europer Pax for secretarial fees and competition. No local transfers will be provided.

- Transfers from international airport to hotel and return, extra fees, 40,00 Euro / Pax minimum 5 people. Less than 5 people the price will be 80,00 Euro / Pax.
- Extra charges for single room ascend to 50,00 € per Pax per day.

Training camp before Championships

For the team they want to organize training camp before the Championships:

- Extra day charged at 110,00 Euro per Pax per day including full board accommodation (breakfast, lunch, dinner and water drink per meal included).
- The cost of renting a lane in swimming pool is 40,00 Euro per lane per hour.
- Charge bottles filling: is free from 7 October.
